

Joomla Highslide Tutorial

When you are looking for fancy popping up pictures and even html pages or Flash movies in Joomla, many ways are possible. Most of you will know LightBox. But there is one I think really blows them all and that is HighSlide.

There is a commercial Joomla extension for that, but that is not what this Joomla Highslide Tutorial is about. Here I will show you what to do to get HighSlide running in Joomla:

First of all download Highslide here: <http://highslide.com/download.php>

After you have downloaded it, you will need to add some code to your template's index.php and you will need to upload the files necessary for highslide.

In the folder you downloaded are samples, but also a folder called "highslide". Upload that entire "highslide" folder to (this is your own choice, but I like simplicity) media/system/js/

Once you have done that we are now ready to adjust the template index.php. Which you will be able to find in: Your Joomla root folder > templates > your template name > index.php open it up with your favorite html / php editor.

In your index.php you need to be sure you paste the following code between the `<body` and `</body` tags.
