Hi,

The sitename is changed in the "Global Configuration" of the Joomla administration part. To get there, you go to the administrative part of Joomla > choose the menu on top called: Site and then the submenu > Global Configuration. See picture (click to enlarge).

Names of menus you change in the menus themselves: go to the menu "Menu", there you will most likely find "Main Menu" and some others. Once you have clicked Main Menu, click on the link of the menu you want to change. After that you will get into the item itself and there you can change the name (see picture).

With an application like DreamWeaver or another html editor you will need to go to your ftp.

Go to the folder: Your Joomla Root folder > templates > beez and open up index.php
